

**SPECIAL AGENT GANPAT V. WAGN
CYBER CRIME TASK FORCE
FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATIONS**

Special Agent (SA) Wagn began his law enforcement career in 1999 as the Chief Deputy with the St. Joseph County Police Department, located in South Bend, IN. His responsibilities included management of the Road Patrol, Detective Bureau, Administrative Services, and Civil Division. Other duties included management of the \$9 million police budget and purchases for the Department.

In December 1999 he started with the FBI, accepting the assignment to the Kansas City Division in March, 2000. Initially he was assigned to a White Collar Crime Squad working Fraud by Wire and Health Care fraud investigations. Other duties included temporary assignments of domestic Terrorism, International Terrorism, and FBI HQ.

In October, 2002 he was assigned to the Cyber Crime Task Force, primarily working Computer Intrusion investigations. SA Wagn currently is assigned as the KC Division Computer Intrusion Program Manager and Primary Relief Supervisor for the Cyber Crime Task Force. SA Wagn is also a member of the Kansas City Division SWAT team, assigned primarily as a sniper.

Prior to 1999, he was on active duty with the U.S. Marines, leaving with the rank of Captain. SA Wagn is a graduate of Slippery Rock University and Boston University. He is married and has four children.
